**Did You Know that** Christian Camp of North Mississippi is a stand-alone, 501(c)(3) organization chartered for the sole purpose of providing and maintaining physical facilities to support Emmaus, Chrysalis and Chrysalis Crossroad Walks? With these Walks and their required team meetings, the Camp is in use over 80% of the weekends each year. When the camp is not actually being used for these Walks and team meetings, our resident camp managers (Ray and Sue Harper) oversee numerous projects required to keep the buildings fresh and up to date so that future Pilgrims can enjoy their Walk just as each of us did. A portion of each pilgrim's or caterpillar's registration fee is used to purchase food and pay our monthly utility expenses. However, 100% of the other required maintenance and capital improvements at the Camp come from the generous contributions of our alumni who know and believe that the Walk to Emmaus and Chrysalis programs are making a difference in local churches all across North Mississippi. We only make one appeal for financial support each year – *and you're in the middle of reading it right now!* We've always been careful to remind all our friends and supporters that support of this mission should never be at the expense of your local church.
